#### THE FOOTBALL TEAM OF THE FERENCVAROSI TORNA CLUB

The Club was established in 1899 in "Ferencváros" an outside district of Budapest, hence the name of the Club. It took part in the first official national football championship in Hungary and since then it has been playing in the first division without a break. It is the most popular club in Hungary just for its glorious past.

Since its establishment it has won the National Championship 20 times:

the Hungarian Cup 9 times:

in 1964 the Inter Cities Fairs Cup, and the Mitropa Cup twice. 1928, 1937.

In addition it has met with success at hundreds of international matches defeating both club teams and those of representative players too. The most outstanding event was that in 1930 it defeated the world champion Uruguayan team of representative players in Uruguay.

Since its establishment the Club has given 90!! representative players to Hungarian football and these players

formed the backbone of the national selection. The Club has been able, at all times, to assure outstanding, world-famed players, as: Imre Schlosser, Dr. György Sarosi, Gyula Lazár, Sándor Kocsis and the present great players: Flórián Albert, Zoltán Varga, Gyula Rákosi, etc.

The leader of the team is Károly Lakat, trainer, who himself, was also an active representative player of FTC for 12 years. His greatest success was that the team led by him won the Olympic Football Championship in 1964 in Tokyo. The team won hands down the 20th championship for the Club in 1967.

The following team was playing at most of the matches:

Géczi, Takács, Novák, Matrai, Pancsics, Juhász, Szücs, Szőke, Varga, Albert, Rákosi, Katona.

At individual matches played: Dr. Fenyvesi, Havasi, Horváth, Dranikovits, Mezei, Karába, Rátkai.

It was the FTC which gave the most players to the Hungarian selection of representative players, in this year. All members of the winning team played also in the "A" or "B" selection of representative players.

Among the reserve players Szikinger and Branikovits are members of the national selection of junior representative players.

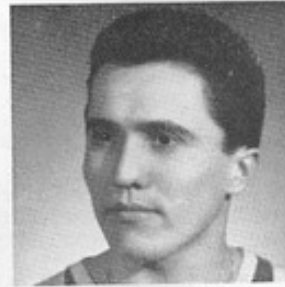

He was not our chairman very long but he made himself, and therefore us, very popular and if I can do anywhere near as well then I feel sure Leeds will stay on top.

You have today, before your very eyes as they say on the Music Halls, two works of major importance to Leeds United and I may say that neither is divorced from the other.

In front of you there is a team which has done you proud and of which we are proud. We can leave that in their own capable hands and in the hands of Don and the knowledgeable men he has around him. To win the League Cup, the first trophy in the club's history, reach the final of the Fairs Cup, the semi-final of the FA Cup, qualify twice for re-entry to the Fairs Cup AND be concerned in the League Championship up to the very last week of the season is not impossible because this is what our team did. But I assure you that it was very hard work and they deserve the highest praise.

We also congratulate those players who were honoured by their country and who therefore brought honour to the club. We wish them more and hope that initial caps come to every member of our playing staff in due course.

And we wish them well this season. We do not say that they will win anything . . . but we do say that they will try their hardest. No one can ask for anything more . . . unless it is "THE YELLAND ROAD ROAR."

### WELCOME TO FERENCVAROS

#### PRIDE OF HUNGARY

IT'S enough to make you blink— opening the season at home with a European final! Truly, wonders never cease. Here we are playing the first leg of the Final of the 1967-68 Inter Cities Fairs Cup before the League season starts on Saturday.

It may not seem quite right in date somehow, but there was nothing else to do what with one thing and another, and in any event it is very enjoyable to make the best of it with such distinguished opponents as Ferencvaros.

We hope their first visit to Elland Road is not the last, and that it is thoroughly pleasant, in all but the result, of course. They are the Manchester United of Hungary, and we could, we have been persistently told, have no more distinguished opponents in Europe today.

All our long slog in the Fairs Cup last winter, first to Luxemburg (for the only easy tie we had), then to Belgrade, and then to Scotland for three gruelling battles with Hibs, Rangers and Dundee, has been well worth while for the reward of seeing what we can do against Ferencvaros.

If we remember the thrilling struggles we have had against other crack Continental sides these last three seasons— against Torino, Valencia, Zaragossa,

Ujpest Dosza (Budapest neighbours of Ferencvaros), Partizan Belgrade and Dynamo Zagreb, for example— then we cannot but warm to the game we play tonight.

We play the second leg in Budapest on Wednesday, September 11th, and we know only too well what a hard job it will be even to draw there with Hungary's favourite side. Much of our chance of winning the Fairs Cup lies in what we do tonight.

#### THE NEW KOP

This is written before Spion Kop in its new form was finished, and we can only hope that all went well in the final stages to make it as commodious, and as comfortable as possible at present for its worthy inhabitants. Other improvements to it will follow, and we hope it will be completely finished before the season is very advanced.

We hope too, that our new flood lighting helps and pleases, for ours has not been the best flood-lit ground in the League, to put it mildly.

We will have another Fairs Cup game for you here on Wednesday, October 23rd— against the Belgian side Standard Liege. By then all our improvements for this season should have been "run in" never mind finished.

This late start is at the request of the Southampton City police, who have that day the extra traffic problems caused by Hampshire's cricket match with the Australians in the city.

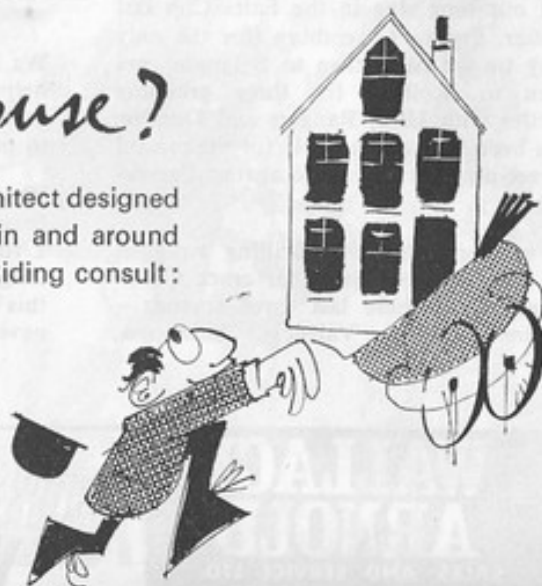

**ISTVAN GECZI** — Normally first-choice goalkeeper. A former junior international, now playing in the "B" class, he is in his seventh season with the club, and is twenty-three years of age.

**BELA TAKACS** — This is the reserve goalkeeper. He is a former Honved star.

**PETER SZINKINGER** — Normally third choice goalkeeper, this seventeen-year-old lad is said to be one of Hungary's most promising young custodians.

**DEZSO NOVAK** — Aged twenty-nine, and a former international who more recently has been playing in the "B" category of games, Novak joined Ferencvaros from Szonbathely, and has given them splendid service since.

**SANDOR MATRAI** — Though now getting towards the veteran stage, being in his thirty-sixth year, Matrai is one of the most capped of Hungarian players, having appeared in no fewer than eighty-one internationals, which is not far short of the record of 100 by Bozsik. Was a member of the Hungarian team which took part in the World Cup in 1966, and is still a great player.

**MIKLOS PANCSICS** — One of the club's own products who has come to international ranking via the various junior clubs and "B" stream. Still young enough, at twenty-three, for making an even bigger name for himself.

**SANDOR HAVASI** — Among the younger members of the current staff Havasi will shortly be nineteen. He joined Ferencvaros from the Kinizsi Husos club, and played against Liverpool in the game at Nép Stadium.

**LASZLO HORVATH** — Another of Ferencvaros's own products and not yet completely established as a regular first-teamer, but a useful member of the replacement squad.

**ISTVAN JUHASZ** — A mid-field linkman, aged twenty-two and a member of the "B" class of representative players.

**LAJOS SZUCS** — Joined Ferencvaros from Dorogi Banyasz, and has made good progress, reaching the "A" level in international honours.

**ISTVAN MEGGYESI** — An eighteen-year-old on the verge of what promises to be a brilliant career at half-back.

**ZOLTAN VARGA** — Capped many times at junior international level, and since honoured at full international status, Varga has been with the club from teenage days.

**FLORIAN ALBERT** — One of the first forwards ever to don his country's colours, Albert gained his first cap ten years ago, succeeding the famous Nandor Hidegkuti when only seventeen. Will be remembered for his brilliant displays in the last World Cup, particularly against Brazil at Goodison Park.

**MATE FENYVESI** — Possessor of many international honours, Dr. Fenyvesi comes next to Sandor Matrai in length of experience, being now thirty-five years of age. Joined Ferencvaros from Kecskemet Kinizsi.

**KAROLY LAKAT** — The Ferencvaros coach. An active representative player for the club for twelve years, he was in charge of the Hungarian side which won in the Tokyo Olympics, and has done splendid work since taking over his present position with Ferencvaros.

**GYULA RAKOSI** — Another much-capped international who starred in the Hungary versus Brazil game at Goodison Park in the World Cup. One of the club's own products.

**LASZLO BRANIKOVITS** — A nineteen-year-old player who has been honoured in junior representative matches and one to watch for the future.

**JANES KARABA** — A versatile player who was recruited from Dorogi Banyasz.

**ISTVAN SZOKE** — Played on the right wing in the game in Budapest against Liverpool, and put over the centre from which Ferencvaros scored the only goal. A member of the "B" international class.

**SANDOR KATONA** — Another former Honved player, and a member of the winning Olympic team in Tokyo in 1964, Katona is a member of the "B" stream of internationals.

**BELA MEZEI** — A nineteen-year-old who joined Ferencvaros from the Fovarosi Autobusz club, and has since gained distinction at junior representative level.
