FERENCVAROS AND THE EUROPEAN CUP

Since the European Cup was founded in 1954 Ferencvaros have been Champions of Hungary on four occasions.

On their first appearance in the 1963/64 competition they were drawn against a Turkish team Galatasaray S.K. In the first match played in Istanbul the Turkish team won 4—0 but in the second leg played in Budapest the home club won 2—0. Ferencvaros therefore made a rapid exit from the competition losing the tie 4—2 on aggregate.

They only had to wait two years for their second appearance and in the 1965/66 competition reached the quarter-finals before being defeated by F.C. International Milan. Their record in this competition reads as follows:—

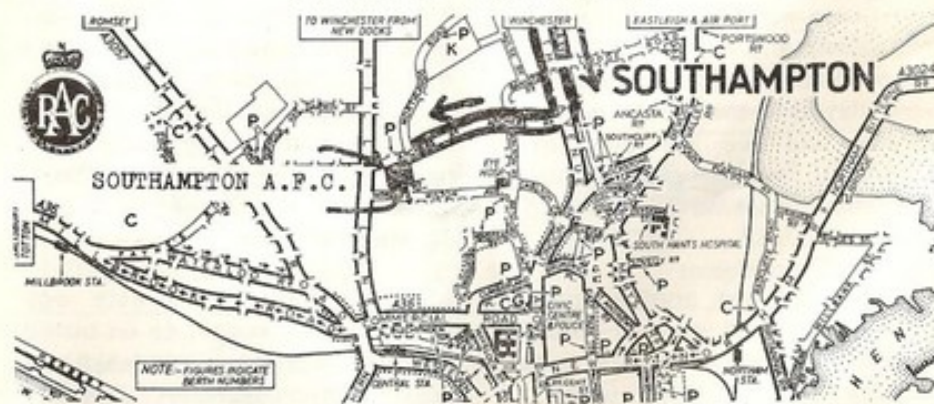
Ferencvaros again won the Hungarian Championship in the 1966/67 season and were therefore nominated for the following season's European Cup Competition. But due to the troubles in the international field the Warsaw Pact Counties withdrew from the competition. Ferencvaros had been drawn to play Glasgow Celtic in the first round but the tie was never played.

And now this year, in which Leeds United are competing for the first time, Ferencvaros were drawn against the Bulgarian Champions Cska Soptomvriisko Zname in the First Round. They won the tie on aggregate 7—4.

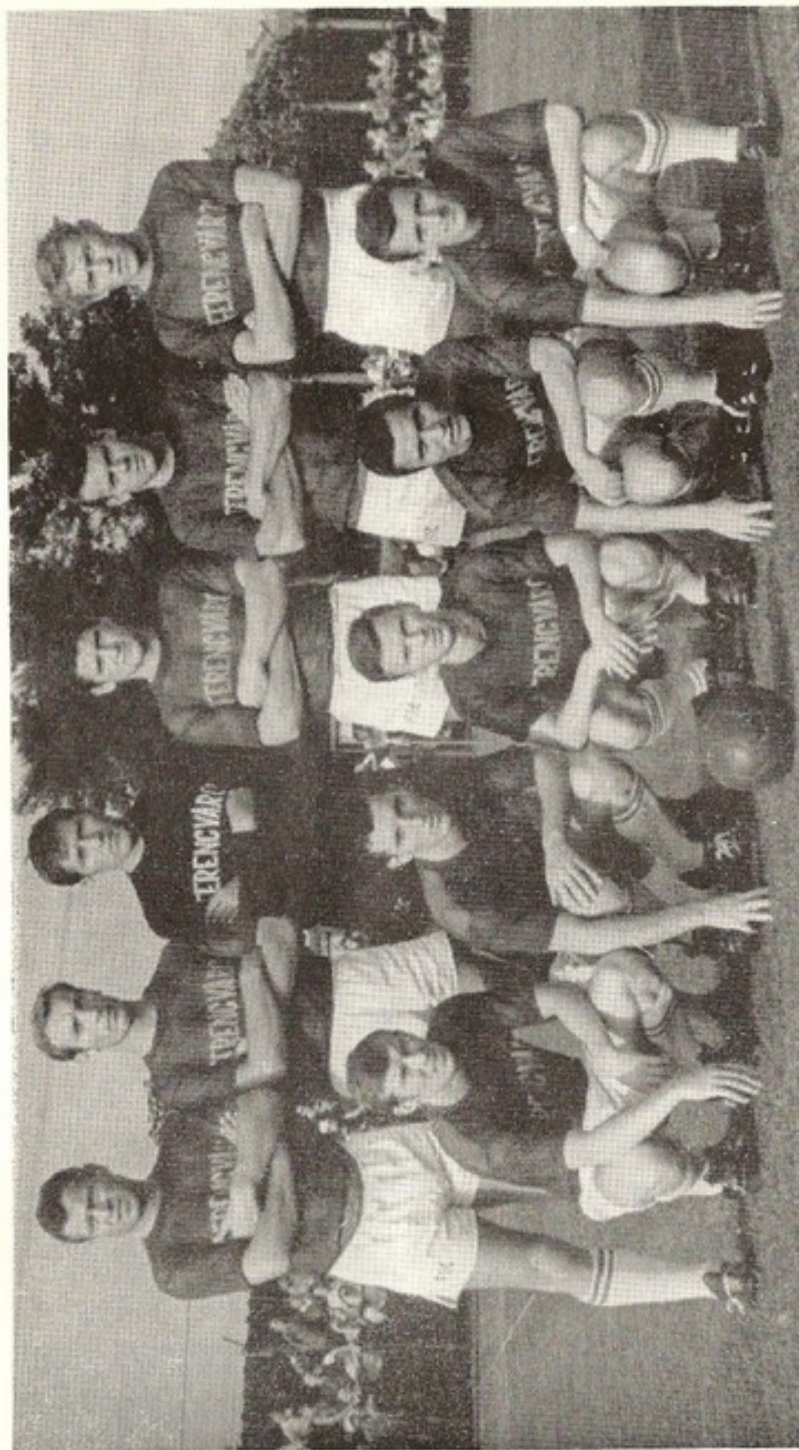
Here is your R.A.C. Route for next week's away game at:

A BRIEF HISTORY OF THE FERENCVAROS CLUB

The Club was founded in 1889 in one of the districts of Budapest called 'Ferencvaros'. From here came the name of the club.

Having already taken part in the first official Hungarian Championship of Football the F.T.C. Club was classed and has since remained in the first category. Thanks to its glorious past Ferencvaros is the most popular club in the country.

In the course of time the F.T.C. Club has twenty-one times won the Championship of Hungary.

They have come out victorious in many hundreds of International Matches, in the course of Inter-Club Competitions and against selected teams. One distinguished victory is the one gained over the selected team of Uruguay the Champions of the World in 1930.

Since its existence, the F.T.C. Club has trained 901 footballers selected to play for Hungary; these players have* always been the mainstay of the National Selected team. Among the F.T.C. footballers eminent sportsmen of universal fame have constantly left their mark on their times, among others Imre Schlessler, Dr. Gydrgy Sarosi, Gyula Lasar, Sandor Kocsis, as well as the outstanding ones of our day: Florian Albert, Gyula Rakrosi, Istvan Juhasz, Miklos Pancsics, Lajos Sziles, Lasslo Branikovits, Istvan Szoke.

The team has been trained by the master of sport KAROLY LAKAT, who himself was an active player in the F.T.C. and a member of the International Team for twelve years. Here is the most outstanding success of his work; under him the team was successful in the Olympic Football Tournament in Tokyo in 1964. In 1967 he was responsible for the F.T.C. winning the Championship of Hungary for the twentieth time, confirming the imposing superiority of the team.

It is in the present year that the Ferencvaros Club has furnished the greatest number of players for the team selected to play for Hungary. Each member of the Champion team has been classed in one of the teams selected International A or B.

Among the reserve players, Szaikinger and Branikovits are members of the National Selected Team of Juniors.

Ever Since 1954 - At Wembley

EVER since those fabulous Hungarians of 1954 came to Wembley and completely demolished the England side under skipper Billy Wright 6—3 (not to mention their 7—1 repeat in Budapest a few weeks later) the name of Hungarian football has ranked with the highest in this country. The astonishment here was just as great when, in that same year, Hungary were beaten by West Germany in the final of the World Cup.

But the British admiration of Hungarian football has been well sustained by Hungarian clubs when they have met the clubs of these islands in the three major European competitions—the European Cup (the Cup of Champions), the European Cup Winners' Cup and the Inter-Cities Fairs Cup—in the last decade or so.

For a comparatively small country with its leading clubs generally from one city, Budapest, Hungary has kept its football high indeed over the years at national and at club level.

Tonight we expect Ferencvaros to be in that same rich tradition. Our two "spies", assistant manager Maurice Lindley and chief coach Syd Owen, whom we sent to watch them play Ujpest Dosza recently, came back with reports

that despite having lost two world class players in Zoltan Varga and Florian Albert since we met them in the Inter-Cities Fairs Cup Final in the summer of 1968. Ferencvaros were still a very fine side, one which would undoubtedly take a leading place in our own First Division.

There will be many here tonight who will remember how difficult we found it to win only 1—0 at Elland Road a year last August thanks to a well snapped goal by centre forward Mick Jones. Even though Ferencvaros concentrated on defence that night, withdrawing even the great Albert at centre forward, they still showed their teeth most dangerously in bursting away on attack out of defence.

At the time of writing it was not known whether Allan Clarke would have recovered from an ankle injury sufficiently to take his place against our visitors tonight. There will be, we know and regret, widespread disappointment if he is unable to play. Ferencvaros are just the sort of class side everybody wants to see him in action against.

He is short of Continental football experience compared with most of our players, and a game against Ferencvaros would broaden any player's knowledge.

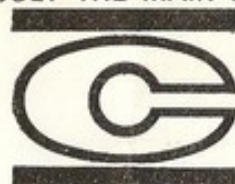

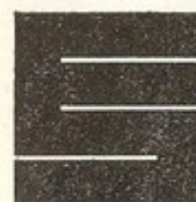

The Saturday after we play Everton here we will be playing in the F.A. Cup. The third round is on Saturday, January 3rd. Only the football gods know what is in store for us this season, and we can think of a few grounds we don't want to visit.

May we pay Everton the compliment of saying that Goodison Park is most of all the ground we don't want to visit!

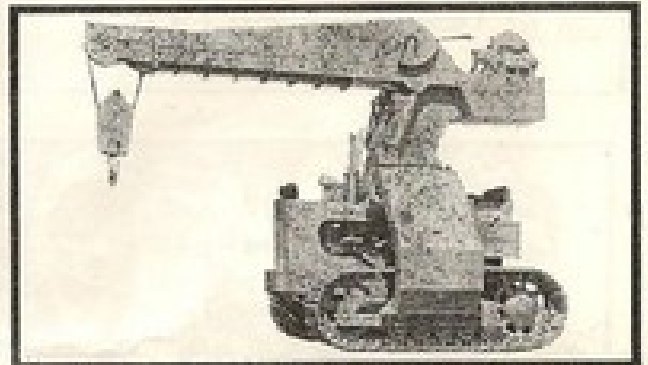
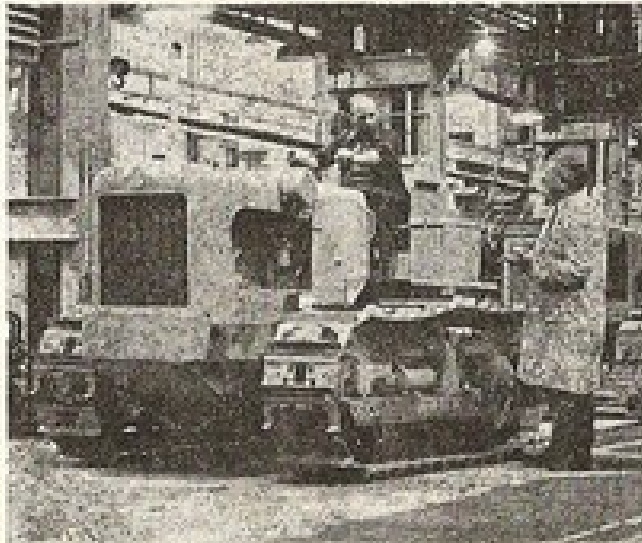

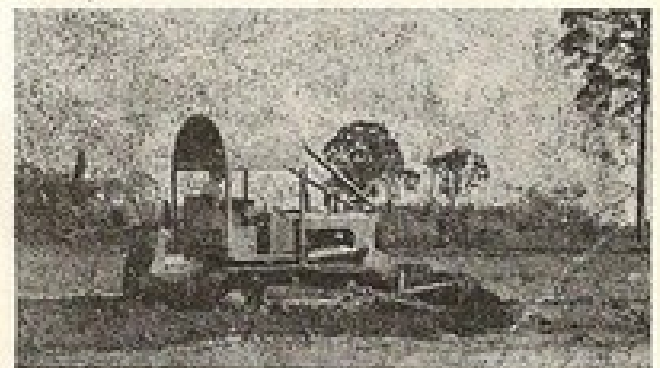
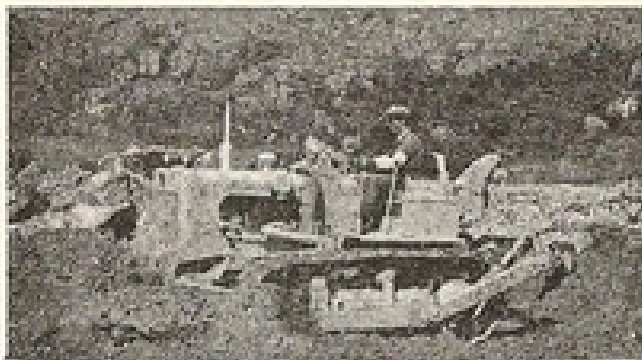
